HOW TO SUBMIT GEM APPLICATION IN ONE DAY

We cordially invite you to apply for a GEM fellowship to receive full tuition, fees, stipend, and paid summer internship(s) for a graduate program (MS or PhD) in engineering or science. If you are determined, you can submit your application in ONE DAY.

If you are interested in starting an engineering or science graduate program in Fall 2009 at a GEM Member University and you are available for a paid summer internship in Summer 2009 with a GEM Employer Member, please start a GEM application today! **The deadline to complete your application is midnight (based on your local time zone) on November 15th!**

PLEASE READ THE HELPFUL TIPS IN PARENTHESIS UNDER EACH ITEM TO FIND OUT HOW YOU CAN COMPLETE THE GEM APPLICATION IN ONE DAY!

GEM Fellowship Application

Here is a checklist of what you will need to submit:

1) Application

Answer all of the questions on the application (Easy to do, takes 15 minutes, make sure you hit SUBMIT by midnight on November 15th)

2) Transcript

Upload your official transcript. (Can't upload official? Unofficial transcripts are often available from your university's website. Upload unofficial by November 15th and mail your official transcript to GEM, 1800 K Street, NW, Suite 900, Washington DC 20006. Make sure we receive your official transcript in our office by December 1, 2008. This is NOT a postmark date.)

3) Resume

Cut and paste your resume in the box provided in the application. (To make your application more attractive to GEM Employers please also upload a formatted resume).

4) Statement of Purpose

Cut and paste at least a one page statement of purpose. (Consider this practice for your graduate school application. Just submit one page of your future goals and how a graduate degree will help you achieve this goal. DO NOT STRESS, just submit a one pager by November 15th).

5) GRE

Indicate the date you are registered to take the GRE, or if you already have your scores submit them on-line. You can also have ETS send GEM your scores. GEM's code is 1305. (To meet the application deadline of November 15th, all you need to do is enter the date you have registered to take the GRE!)

6) Recommendation Letters

You must submit 3 recommenders email addresses for your recommenders to submit letters on-line. We must receive the actual letters by December 1, 2008; this is not a postmark date. (All recommender email addresses must be entered on-line by November 15th)

Feel free to check your application frequently because we will be updating it as we identify and validate your documents.
